The [Greater Richmond School of Music](#) (GRSM) will provide music instruction through extra-curricular private, semi-private and group lessons in addition to the [GRSM Band Program](#) at All Saints Catholic School for 2023-2024. Instruction will be available for **piano, voice, ukulele, as well as all orchestra and band instruments.**

Registration is available by [CLICKING HERE](#) or by scanning the QR code above. Tuition is payable in full up front, half at the beginning of each semester, or in equal monthly payments during the session. There is a one-time Family Registration Fee of \$25. PRIVATE LESSON registration is OPEN YEAR ROUND and TUITION is pro-rated.

There will be NO CLASSES on [days that ASCS is closed](#) or on [Early Dismissal days](#)

Lesson schedule and tuition calculations will be emailed the week before each student's first lesson.

Lessons begin the week of September 4th

Private Lessons

Private lessons provide focused, one-on-one instruction with a master teacher. Students will spend the lesson time being shown all that is necessary for them to practice during the week in preparation for their next lesson, so that they can consistently progress.

Semi-Private Lessons

Semi-Private lessons allow for two students in the same lesson with a master teacher. Students should be within 2 yrs of age of each other, studying the same instrument, at the same level. As with private lessons, practice is the key to success. Private and Semi-Private lessons are scheduled weekly during the term and are offered in 30, 45, or 60 minute intervals. Other than keyboards, which will be available for on-site use, each student must bring their own instrument to the lesson each week. Limited rentals from GRSM are available for keyboards and ukuleles at a rate of \$20/month.

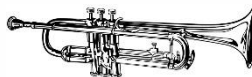
Recitals are included in tuition and will be held at the end of each semester for all registered students who are interested.

Keyboard Musician A

(Gr 1-4)

The Keyboard Musician class is a perfect musical start for your school aged child. Classes move very quickly into reading and comprehending music, based on each child's ability. Concepts covered include: early note reading, singing (with solfege syllables), rhythms, pattern and concept finding, proper piano technique/posture, how to practice, theory, history, listening, games, movement, and playing with expression. The term recital is included in tuition.

Intro to Strings

(Gr 2-5)

The **Introduction to Strings** course for children is designed to give a basic introduction to the violin, viola, cello and double bass. Students will learn proper left/right hand techniques, anatomy of the instrument, how to produce a sound, and simple musical concepts. Students would also work on rhythms and simple songs, in addition to the basic instrument posture/bow hold. The course would then go on to teach more challenging beginning strings music and expand on concepts and techniques to get the student ready for further group or individual study. Students must provide their own instrument, and recitals are included in tuition.

Beginning Band

(Gr 4-8)

The **Beginning Band** is a full year beginning level group for students who are learning to play a band instrument for the first time. Instruction is focused on developing a solid foundation in note reading, tone production, rhythm, articulation, proper posture/hand position, and instrument care and maintenance. Students also learn basic music theory concepts and ensemble skills, such as balance and blend. Beginning Band members at All Saint's School receive a 1 hr group lesson each week. As a performance date nears, the ASCS beginning band students will join with beginning band students from other schools that participate in the [GRSM Band Program](#) and rehearse as a full ensemble.

Each student must bring their instrument, lesson book and music stand to class every week.

Appropriate instruments for the Beginning Band are **trumpet, trombone, flute, clarinet, saxophone and percussion** (multiple instruments), and GRSM can provide information regarding purchase or rental options. No previous music experience is necessary.
