The Greater Richmond School of Music (GRSM) will provide music instruction through extra-curricular private and group lessons at St. Benedict Catholic School, for the 2023-2024 school year. Instruction is currently available for piano, voice, ukulele, guitar, banjo, as well as all orchestra and band instruments.

Tuition is payable in full up front, half at the beginning of each semester, or in equal monthly payments during the session. There is a one-time Family Registration Fee of \$25. Keyboard Musician A

(Gr 1-4)

The Keyboard Musician class is a perfect musical start for your school aged child. Classes move very quickly into reading and comprehending music, based on each child's ability. Concepts covered include: early note reading, singing (with solfege syllables), rhythms, pattern and concept finding, proper piano technique/posture, how to practice, theory, history, listening, games, movement, and playing with expression. The term recital is included in tuition.

Tuition: \$330 (\$66/month, Sept-Jan)

Materials needed: Lesson Book(s), Keyboard at home for practice.



****NEW** "Jam Band"**

(Gr 4-8)

The GRSM Jam Band program is designed for students to play together in contemporary bands. Bands can be formed with any number of different instruments but ideally, bands will feature guitar, bass, drums, keyboards, and vocals/horns (instrumental groups are also fine.)



Day of week: Wednesdays 9/6/23-1/17/24 (1st semester)

Time: 3:00-4:00pm

Tuition: \$289 (57.80/month Sept-Jan)

Materials needed: Instrument, Music as prescribed, Folding music stand

Pre-requisite: 1 FULL year of lessons on instrument

Beginning Band

The Beginning Band is a full year beginning level group for students who are learning to play a band instrument for the first time. Instruction is focused on developing a solid foundation in note reading, tone production, rhythm, articulation, proper posture/hand position, and instrument care and maintenance. As a performance date nears, the SBCS beginning band students will join with beginning band students from other schools that participate in the GRSM Band Program and rehearse as a full ensemble.

Day of Week: Fridays 9/8/23 – 5/17/24 (full year)

Time: 3:00-4:00pm

Tuition: \$520 (\$58/month, Sept-May)

Materials needed: Lesson Book, Instrument, Folding Music Stand

Appropriate instruments for the Beginning Band are **trumpet, trombone, flute, clarinet, saxophone and percussion** (multiple instruments). No previous music experience is necessary.



Private Lessons

Private lessons provide focused, one-on-one instruction with a [master teacher](#). Students will spend the lesson time being shown all that is necessary for them to practice during the week in preparation for their next lesson, so that they can consistently progress.



Semi-Private Lessons

Semi-Private lessons allow for two students in the same lesson with a [master teacher](#). Students should be within 2 yrs of age of each other, studying the same instrument, at the same level. As with private lessons, practice is the key to success.

Private and Semi-Private lessons are scheduled weekly during the term. Other than keyboards, which will be available for on-site use, each student must bring their own instrument to the lesson each week. Limited rentals from GRSM are available for keyboards, ukuleles and guitars at a rate of \$20/month.

Recitals are included in tuition and will be held at the end of each semester.

Private and Semi-Private instruction is offered at St. Benedict's as listed below.

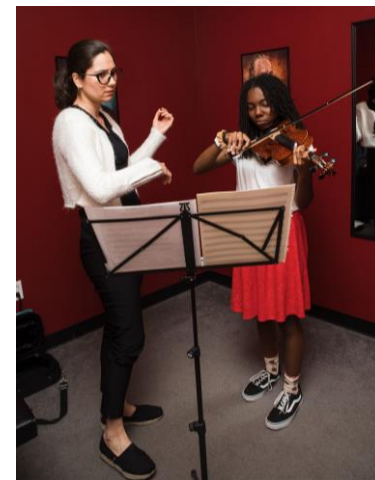
